# The Lothians Family History Society

The Society aims to help like-minded people interested in family history. Whether you are a beginner or experienced researcher, meeting together gives you the opportunity to share your interests and to learn more about researching your family tree.

The Lothians Family History Society covers Mid, East and West Lothian as well as the city of Edinburgh. We meet each Wednesday evening in Bonnyrigg, 7 miles south of Edinburgh, and are ideally placed for all the national records which can be found in the city. Evening visits to New Register House in Edinburgh take place on the fourth Wednesday of the month. These can be booked in advance at a cost of £10 per person.

Being a member, whether local, distant or overseas, entitles you to three newsletters a year, attendance at monthly meetings with expert speakers on a wide range of interesting topics and subjects, workshop sessions and access to our ever-growing library of research materials. We can use the school computers in the library to access the worldwide web and other CD-ROM based material.



Members of the society have been actively involved in indexing the 1841, 1851 and 1861 Censuses for Midlothian, which are for sale. These are now complete and a start has been made on the Burial indexes for Midlothian which are available on CD..

The newsletters and Members Interest booklet provide information about research being done by members and are a forum for requests for help from outside the area. We run a transcription service at a small charge and members can also be put in touch with experienced researchers if required. The Society has members all over the

world and, with such a wide membership there are lots of possible links.

In addition the society hosts a website (see address overleaf) giving details about the facilities and services, price lists, and worldwide web links to assist your research. Look out for our Noticeboard where you can post queries and receive advice on how to progress your research. You may also find some of the answers to others queries to be of interest.

To join the society, please complete and detach the application form and send it to the address overleaf. You will be sent a welcome pack along with a membership number. The welcome pack includes a copy of the latest newsletter, a list of Members Interests, a sales list as well as other information to help your research. Everyone is welcome at our Wednesday evening meetings in the library of the
